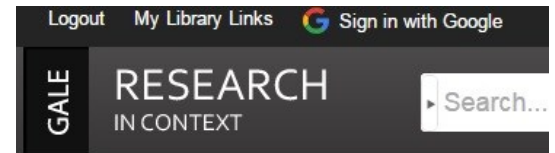


# Gale Research in Context Database

1. Go to "Online Resources" on EMS Library webpage
2. Click on "Gale Research in Context" icon (Password: rockschools)
3. Sign in with Google on top left corner  
(Use your school email: ID#@students.rps205.com)
4. Login to Google Drive (Google Drive & Gale Database both need to be open and logged into)
5. Search topic in the search bar; results may include topic page, images, references, videos, news articles, magazines, etc.

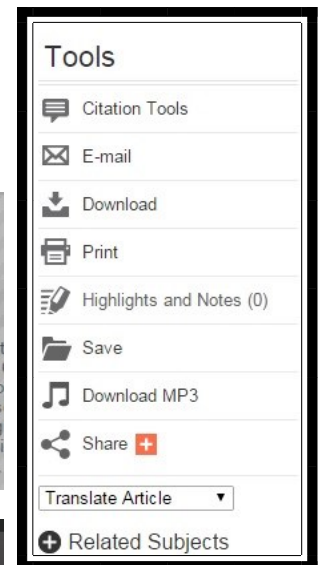
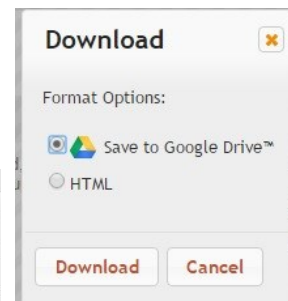
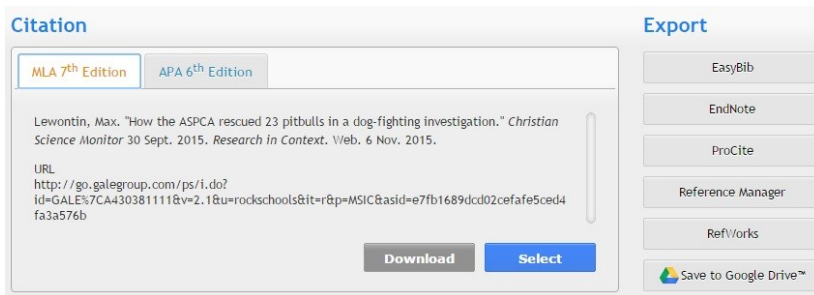
## Tools: Highlights and Notes & Citation

1. Click "Highlights & Notes". Highlight the fact you want to use. A box will pop up to pick highlight color. Under notes, write Fact # and type sentence in your own words. **Copying word for word is plagiarism!** Click save. Repeat this for every fact you want to use in your research.

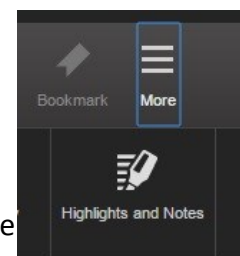

2. After highlighting is complete, click on "Download".
3. Choose "Save to Google Drive" then click "Download".
4. Click on "Citation Tools" and click "Save to Google Drive".



5. Go to "More" at the top of the page & click it to get a drop down box. Click "Highlights and Notes". Click on "Download" and choose "Save to Google Drive." Click "Download".



## Google Drive

1. Open "Research in Context" folder in your Google Drive
2. Everything that you downloaded will be in that file to open and use: Highlighted Article, Highlighted Fact Chart, and Citations
